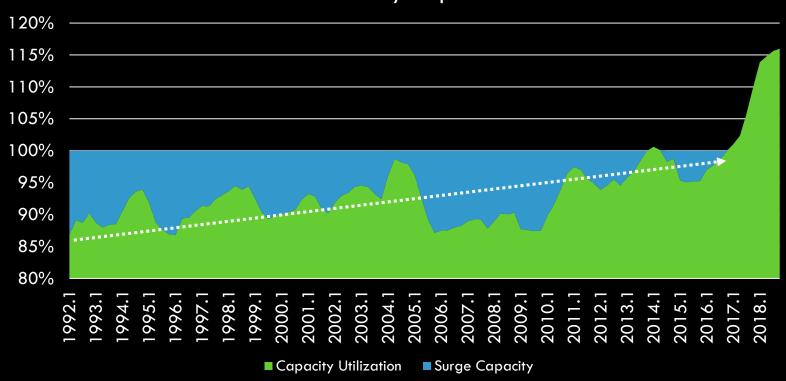

# CAPACITY UTILIZATION & SURGE CAPACITY

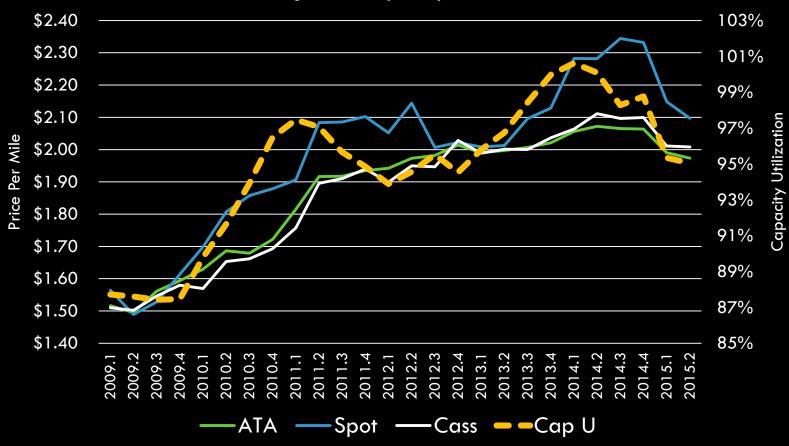
FTR Active Capacity Utilization

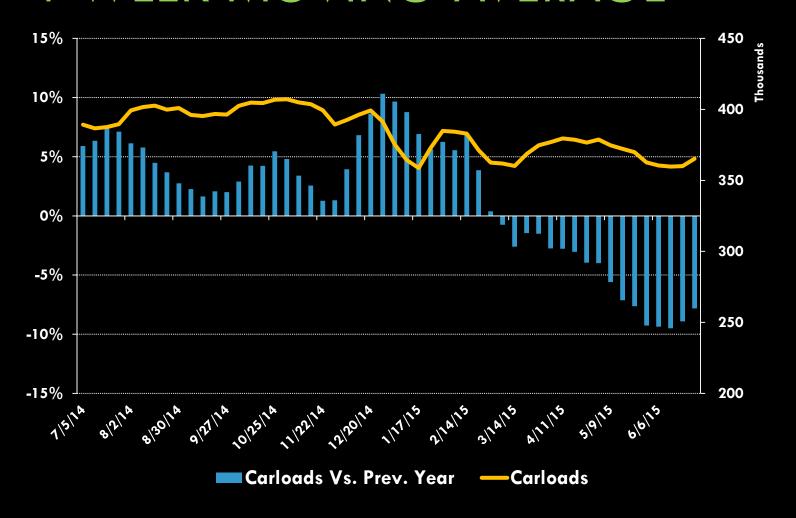

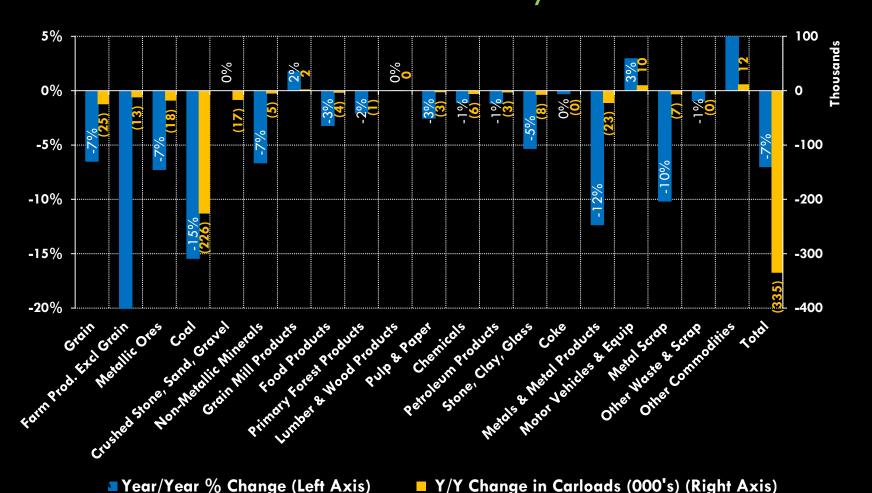

#### N.A. CARLOADS THRU WEEK 25 4-WEEK MOVING AVERAGE





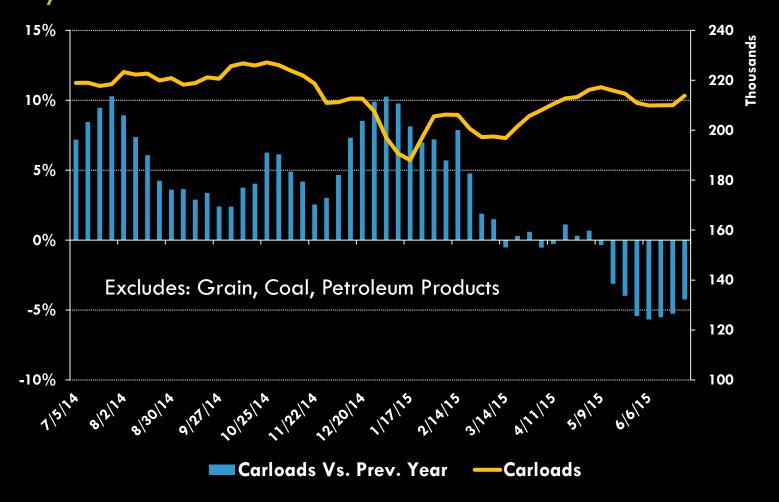
### Q2 CARLOAD Y/Y VOLUME CHANGE Q2 THRU 6/27

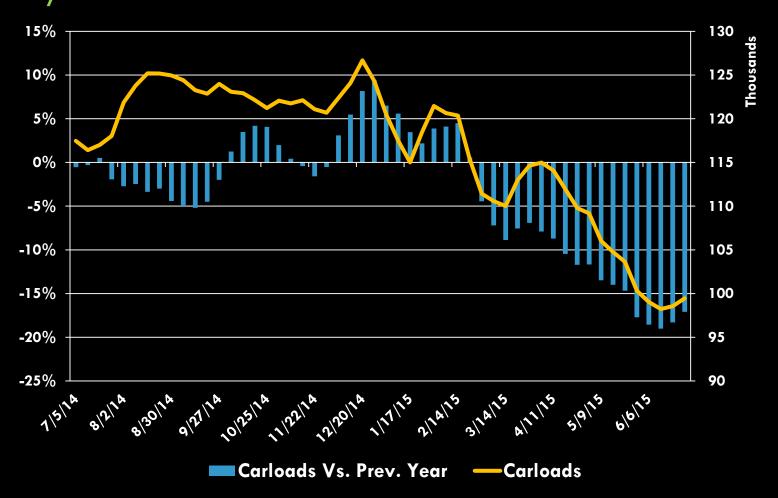
# N.A. SELECTED CARLOADS THRU 6/27 - 4-WEEK MOVING AVG.

# N.A. COAL CARLOADS THRU 6/27 - 4-WEEK MOVING AVG.



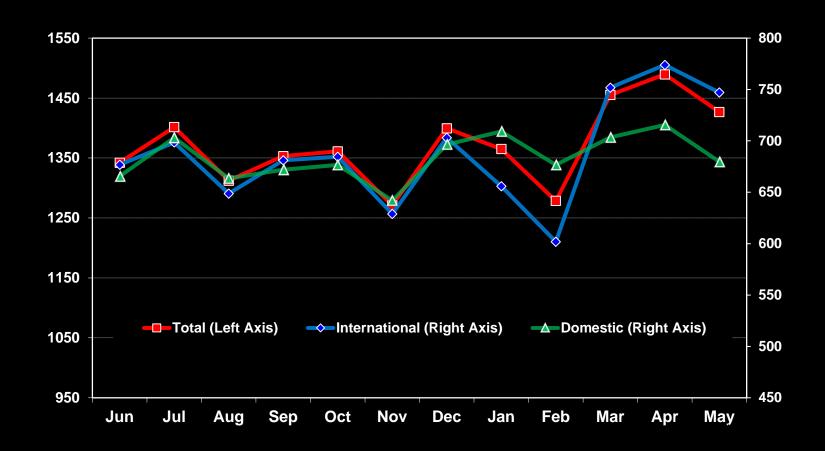


# AVERAGE CLASS I TRAIN SPEEDS ALL TRAINS



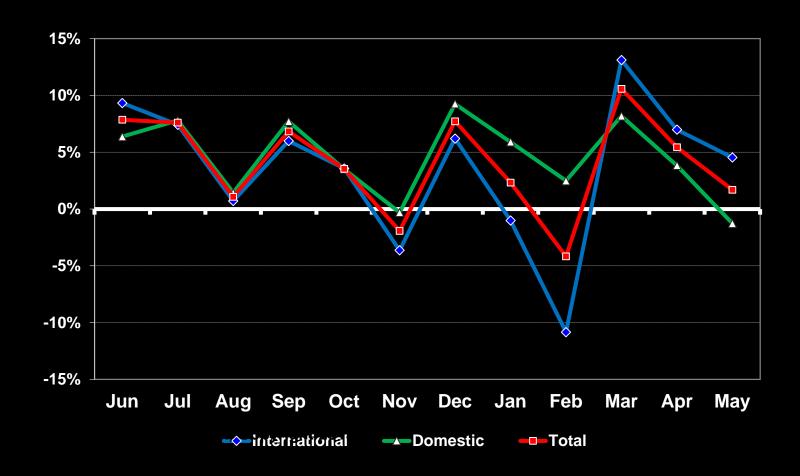


# SEASONAL ADJUSTMENTS REVEAL DOMESTIC NOT GROWING MUCH



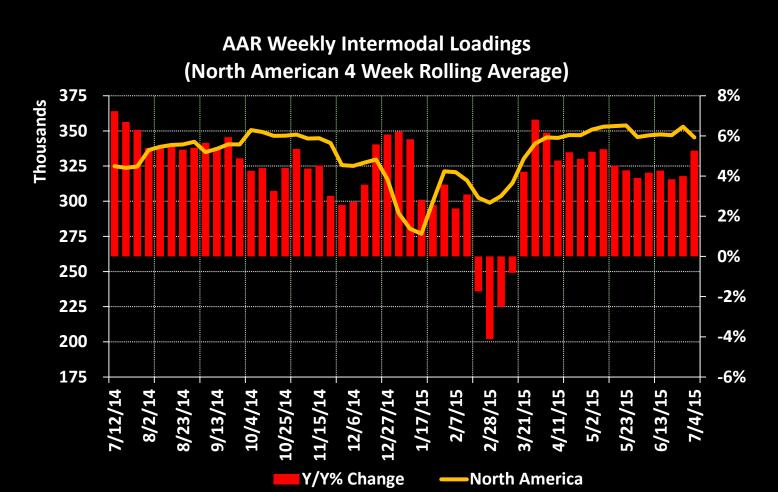


# MAY WAS A WEAK MONTH FOR DOMESTIC

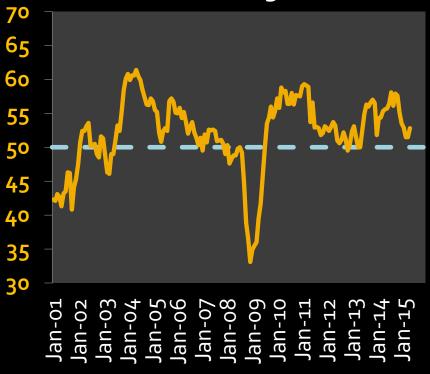

#### **Core Capital Goods Orders**

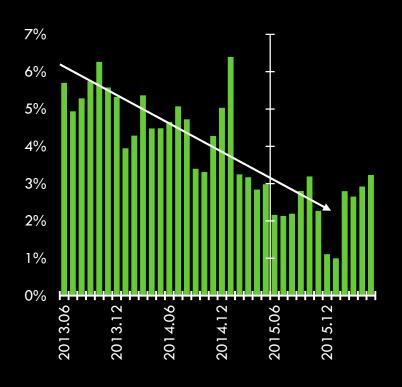

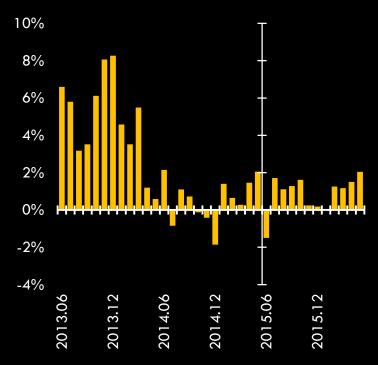


## LOADINGS ARE WEAKENING

## Super Long-Haul Loadings (>550 miles)



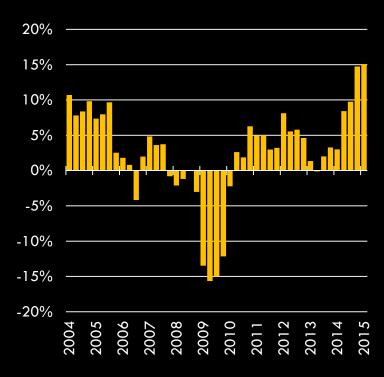


# PROFITS ARE GOOD - COST MIX IS CHANGING
